Homework

Homework will continue to be posted online each week. This will be published on our website each Friday in the section entitled 'Homework'. For this term, children will have weekly spellings and a times-tables task.

Times Table Rockstars

In Year 2 we begin to learn our 2-, 3-, 5- and 10-times tables. Times Table Rock stars is an on-line app we use in school to make learning times tables fun. Your child will take home their username and password on Friday – please look out for it in their bookbags.

PE

Our PE lessons will take place on Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure that your child has the relevant kit, to include black shorts, a plain white t shirt and black pumps which should be clearly labelled.
